



Leave of absence was granted to members who could not attend the online meeting. Agenda mentioned below were discussed and resolutions (as mentioned below) were passed by the academic council:

Agenda 1: To Read and Confirm Minutes of the last meeting: Minutes of the last meeting held on 14/6/2022 were read by Dr. Moses Kolet and confirmed by the council. Dr. Kolet proposed **Resolution No 20** (in continuation of earlier resolutions) to confirm the minutes which was seconded by Dr. Sudhakar Agarkar and the resolution was unanimously passed. Action Taken Report was presented before the council.

Agenda 2: To approve syllabus of new PG programme under autonomy: M.Sc. in Fire Science, Disaster Management and Industrial Safety (FDI): Prin. Dr. Kolet gave a brief introduction to this new programme approved by the BOS in Inter Disciplinary Science and planned for introduction from coming AY 2023-24. Dr Kolet proposed the title be revised to PG programme in Fire Science and Industrial safety as later suggested by members of the BOS and Academic Council, which was accepted by the Academic Council. Dr. Kolet invited

proposed course and job opportunities available. Dr. Sudhakar Agarkar suggested the course be made available to graduates from any faculty and bridge Course be designed for students from Arts and Commerce faculty willing to take up this programme. Dr Shobhana asked about batch size per year to which Dr. Kolet replied 25 students per year would be admitted. Dr. A.P. Jayaraman shared his experiences regarding this course in BARC and suggested topics such as Chemical Disasters and Industrial Toxicology for incorporation in the syllabus. Dr Jayaraman also went through the list of references and suggested books such as Industrial Hygiene published by ACGIH, USA. Dr A.P Jayaraman and all members appreciated the course and gave their approval. **Resolution No. 21** for approval of the 2 Years PG (M.Sc.) Programme on Fire Science and Industrial Safety was proposed by Prin. Dr. Kolet and seconded by Dr. A.P. Jayaraman and Dr. Gajanan Vader and the PG programme was approved for introduction from AY 2023-24.

Agenda 3: To approve syllabus of new PG programme under autonomy: M.Sc. in Statistical Data Analysis: New MSc programme in Statistical Data Analysis approved by the BOS in Statistics for implementation by Department of Statistics from coming AY 2023-24 was presented before the Academic Council by HOD I/C Ms. Sumaiya Shaikh. Graduates in Statistics, Physics, Mathematics, Information Technology (IT) and Computer Science (CS) from any recognized university would be eligible to enrol for this programme. The external experts appreciated the new program which was granted approval by the academic council. **Resolution No. 22** was proposed by Ms. Sumaiya Shaikh and seconded by Dr Shobhana Vasudevan and Dr. Uma Shankar and passed unanimously in this effect.


Agenda 4: Syllabi up-gradation of TYBSc: Updated syllabi of Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Statistics, Human Science, Computer Science and Information Technology, approved and passed in the respective Boards of Studies were presented for approval of the Council. The Heads/ Incharges of Departments presented their respective syllabi approved by their Boards of Studies. Dr. Shobhana Vasudevan, Dr. Uma Shankar, Dr. Gajanan Wader, Dr. A.P Jayaraman, Dr. Sudhakar Agarkar, Dr. Sunil Kumar Deshmukh all actively deliberated upon the upgradations and gave their comments and views. Heads/ Incharges of PG Departments of Data Science and Clinical Psychology which had begun functioning from current AY 2022-23, presented their detailed syllabi for Part II/ Second Year of their course.
