- **2.** Welcome: The Chairperson introduced and welcomed all the members of the Board of Studies of Department of Microbiology constituted as per the UGC guidelines for Autonomous colleges, Uniform Statue No.158 (Statues framed under Section 72(10) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016) and Govt. of Maharashtra, Higher and Technical Education Department Notification of 14th Jan 2019 and thanked them for their kind acceptance.

- 5. Suggestions from the Experts: The session was then open for suggestions and comments from the experts. Academic experts gave some valuable insights with respect to the upcoming autonomy and changes proposed. The suggestions received were as follows:

By Dr. Nupur Mehrotra:

- a. In paper 302, unit 3 only classification of plant metabolites should be included and biosynthesis is not required.
- b. Enzyme inhibition and applications of Enzymes in different fields should be added in paper 401 unit I.
- c. Shift endocrinology unit from paper 401 to paper 402 and adding membrane transport originally present in unit 2 of paper 402 to unit 2 of paper 401.

By Dr. Jyoti D Vora:

- a. Add chloride shift with respect to body physiology & its diagnostic importance.
- b. Addition of corona virus along with other virus type in unit 1 of paper 303
- c. Remove Introduction to Genomic and metagenomic approaches from unit 1 of paper 403 as it will be too much for bachelor's level.

By Dr. Utkarsha Lekhak:

- a. Remove other types of microscopy in paper 301 and add AFM to be included as it's basics would be required while learning nano technology.
- b. To include other types of waste in unit 3 of paper 403 along with e-waste management.

By Dr. Murali Krishna Chilakapati:

Sir agreed with all the suggestions given by other all the esteemed BOS members while he informed all faculty members to ensure expertise while teaching analytical techniques to students.

By Kanad Ghaisas:

He suggested that students should be given hands on experience on all the practical's that were conducted online during pandemic.
