VPM's B.N. BANDODKAR COLLEGE OF SCIENCE (AUTONOMOUS), THANE 1.4.2 Action Taken Report related to Feedback Analysis of Syllabus

- In order to give career orientation from FYBSc class, BOS of various subjects introduced 16 new value added certificate courses with credits. Similarly 13 existing courses were upgraded within the credit framework under autonomy.
- Due to limitations of the Science stream, topics based on professional ethics, gender, and human value can not be included at substantial level. However environmental issues and awareness about the concept of sustainable nature were incorporated in revised syllabi of SYBSc.
- In framing S.Y.B.Sc. syllabi content, volume of content or learning load, suitability for slow learners was taken into consideration.
- In order to enhance reference materials for science subjects, the central library subscribed to Knimbus digital platform and J-Gate database for accessing e-books, e-journals and other online resources.
- For T.Y.B.Sc revised syllabi preparation, students, teachers, alumni and employer feedback w.r.t existing syllabi was communicated to HODs to take necessary action through BOS.
- As BNBCS is following 'Stepwise Syllabus Revision Policy', M.Sc. Part I and Part II syllabi will be revised in 2023-24 and 2024-25 respectively by taking inputs from all stakeholder's feedback.
