	Welcome: The Chairman of the Board of Studies, Dr. V.M.Jamdhade BOSs of the Department of Botany, welcomed and introduced the members of the Board of Studies and thanked them all for spending their valuable time attending the meeting. The Department of Botany's Board of Studies was formed according to the UGC guidelines for autonomous colleges, Uniform Statute No.158 (Statutes framed under Section 72 (10) of the Maharashtra 1 Public Universities Act, 2016), and the Govt. of Maharashtra, Higher and Technical Education Department Notification of 14th January 2019, and they received recognition for their approval.
BOs/BOT 1.2	Agenda No.2: Review and discussion on the NEP-2020 syllabus for T.Y. B.Sc. Botany (Major and Minor) to be implemented from the academic year 2025–2026.
	Dr. Urmila madam introduced the major, minor courses of T.Y.B.Sc. Botany to the members. Urmila madam had mentioned the addition of a Discipline Specific Course (Theory and Practical) to the major students. The Vocational Skill Enhancement Course (VSEC) was also shown to the members. Introduction of the 'Instrumentation' course to the minor students. She mentioned that minor students will attend only the semester five botany course. Elaborative talk on field projects and on job training was given by Urmila madam. Entire syllabus unit wise explained by the madam.
	In the Microbiology unit, synchronize the practicals according to the theory suggested by Dr. Rathod sir.

 Dr. Nemade sir mentioned in Plant Biotechnology-I & Medicinal Botany unit that while taking clinical trials, students should know the protocols, SOPs, and techniques of animal handling. Addition of Cobalt and Molybdenum minerals and their sources and origin should be added in the Nutrition unit suggested by Dr. Nemade sir. In the Nutrition unit, he made a point of replacing Yogurt as a probiotic food with Curd. He proposed to add the disadvantages of food colour (Red and Green). He encouraged mentioning the common deficiencies of Iron, Protein and Vitamins in diet. In theory part of the Nutrition unit, Dr. Shetty madam recommended introducing sub points related to the advantages and disadvantages of cold drinks, Protein supplements (Artificial Vs. Natural). In the Nutrition unit, under the Psychobiotics sub point, Shetty madam suggested to add Anorexia nervosa, Bulimia nervosa, and Binge eating disorders. In semester six, Plant Diversity-IV course, Dr. Bhavna madam suggested adding one monocot family. In the Physiology unit, she also mentioned to add Magnesium as a macronutrient and Selenium as a micronutrient. In semester six, under Discipline Specific Elective Courses, Dr. Shetty had suggested the course title as 'Sustainable solutions'.
