Agenda 1: To read and confirm the minutes of the previous meeting held on 15th November 2022: Minutes of the earlier meeting held on 15/11/2022 were read and confirmed.

Agenda 2: To approve AQAR 2021-2022: AQAR for year 2021-22 was discussed by Dr. (Mrs) V. D. Manjramkar and approved for uploading. Dr. V.D. Manjramkar also put forward need for *Divanjan* policy for the college and the need for toilet for handicapped and also instructions in braille.

Agenda 3: To finalize policy for endowment prizes in CGPA system: Shri Abhijeet Kale explained the policy for selection of candidates for endowment prizes based on CGPA system, which was granted approval by the CDC. It was finalized to select prize winners by grade and to consider marks in case of similar grades.

Agenda 4: To grant approval for Research policy: The new research policy was explained by Dr. V.M. Jamdhade and approved by the CDC. Vacant seats in research were discussed. Dr. Jamdhade said new research guides should apply for recognition. Dr. Kolet and Dr. V.D. Manjramkar stated that previously research guides were first granted recognition for M.Sc (By Research) and then for Ph.D. which was followed currently, however there were some exceptions and requirements would also change after implementation of NEP. The need for seed money for research was discussed and the Management asked CDC to draft seed money policy and expressed happiness to help. Dr. Vijay Bedekar suggested help from alumni in generating funds for research. Dr. Vijay Bedekar said the Management will be happy to give



certificates to achievers in research. Dr. Vijay Bedekar also inquired about colloquium lectures and was updated on the same by Dr. Kolet.

Agenda 5: Any other matter with the permission of the chair:

5A: Infrastructure: Dr. Vijay Bedekar said to make maximum use of available infrastructure. Members suggested need for shed to be put up on the terrace for additional infrastructure.

5B: Training in CPR and Disaster Management: Dr. Mahesh Bedekar suggested training in CPR and Disaster Management be given to all teachers and later on also to students.
