Minutes of the fifteenth meeting of the College Development Committee held on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> May 2022 at 12.30 PM in the Conference Hall.

Leave of Absence was granted to Shri C.G. Patil, Dr. M. Saha, Mrs M. U. Shiudkar and Shri Girish Lele.

Agenda No. 1: To read and confirm the minutes of the previous meeting held on 21st March 2022: Minutes of the earlier meeting held on 21/3/2022 were read and confirmed.

**Agenda No. 2:** To seek approval for the Budget for A.Y. 2022-23: Budget for the year 2022-23 was tabled before the CDC, which granted approval for the budget.

Agenda No. 3: To approve credit policy with elective and core courses: Credit policy of the college under autonomy was approved by the CDC. Under this policy, the basic 120 academic credits as per the existing UGC/ University scheme @ 40 credits per year would be continued to facilitate easy entry /exit of students from/to other institutions in between the programme. However, under autonomy, every learner must collect at least 12 credits through completion of credit based certificate courses made available in the college or other institutions/ portals (with approval of the Principal in consultation with Examination Committee and Management) and a maximum of 2 credits for academic /co curricular and extra-curricular leadership/ exemplary achievements (to be approved by Principal in consultation with Examination Committee and Management) so as to have a minimum of 132 credits in his/her 3 years of study in the college and to be eligible for award of degree under autonomy. This credit policy would be applicable from 2022-23 progressively, starting with FYBSc 2022-23.

Under the additional 12 credits, it was resolved to make some courses compulsory for students to help them with collection of additional credits. Courses namely, 3 credit certificate course on Management for Beginners and 2 credits Central Public Administration System were resolved to be made mandatory for FYBSc students and 2 Credits Course on Basic Law for Science Students was resolved as mandatory for SYBSc students, fees of which would be collected at the time of admission to the respective classes.

Similarly provision of electives along with core subjects as required under autonomy was also granted approval. Dr. S.D. Rathod pointed out additional teachers would be required in case of elective subjects being taught to which Dr Kolet replied it would have to be worked out and sanctioned as per the case and need arising in case of students opting for electives.

Agenda No. 4: To approve minor rise of Rs. 400/- in 'other fees' heading of TYBSc classes on account of convocation and alumni association fees: The committee granted its unanimous approval to a minor rise in fees under heading of 'other fees' to be collected from TYBSc students as their fees for alumni association as well as for expenses incurred for convocation. The rise would apply for students taking admission to TYBSc classes from AY 2022-23 onwards.

### Agenda No. 5: Any other matter with permission of the chair:

5a: The new executive committee for Anubandh Past Student's Association was granted approval by the CDC wef January 2022.

5b. Activities of alumni during the year 2021-22 were put before the CDC and approved.

5c. List of 25 (plus 3 courses mentioned below) credit based certificate courses was put before the CDC for sanction and granted approval as credit based short courses to be conducted under autonomy..
