

The following agenda were discussed and resolutions as mentioned below were passed by the body

Agenda 1: To Read and Confirm minutes of the last meeting held on 14th June 2021: Minutes of the earlier meeting held on 14/6/2021 were read and confirmed.

Governing Body Resolution No. 9: The Governing body resolved to confirm minutes of the earlier meeting held on 14/6/2021.

Agenda 2: To approve new programme M.Sc. in Data Science (approved in BOS, IT; Academic Council, Finance Committee): The new programme, namely, M.Sc. in Data Science to be started from Academic Year 2022-23 was explained to the members by Shri A.A. Kale. Prof Man Mohan expressed happiness over curriculum contents of the programme and the members unanimously approved the programme, namely, M.Sc. in Data Science.

Governing Body Resolution No. 10: The Governing Body unanimously resolved to approve the new programme M.Sc. in Data Science to be introduced from AY 2022-23.

Agenda 3: To approve new programme M.Sc. in Clinical Psychology (approved in BOS, Human Science; Academic Council, Finance Committee): The second new programme to be introduced under autonomy from Academic Year 2022-23 was tabled before the body. Dr. Moses Kolet said that being a science college, we can offer degrees in Psychology and B.Sc. and M.Sc. degrees in Psychology are in vogue. Dr. Vishnu Kanhere said there was a huge demand for this course and suggested internships and tie up with hospitals for students opting for this course. The members unanimously approved this new programme, namely, M.Sc. in Clinical Psychology.

Governing Body Resolution No. 11: The Governing Body unanimously resolved to approve the new programme M.Sc. in Clinical Psychology to be introduced from AY 2022-23.



Agenda 4: To approve credit policy under autonomy (approved in Academic Council):120 credits as per existing norms for colleges; 12 additional credits to be collected by learner in 3 years of UG study: Prin. Dr. Moses Kolet put before the body the new credit policy of the college approved by the Academic Council to be introduced under autonomy, viz. 120 credits to be allotted to learners as per the existing UGC and University of Mumbai norms so as to facilitate easy entry and exit to learners wishing to leave for joining elsewhere or coming into our college from other institutes in their second or third years. In addition, a minimum additional score of 12 credits would be collected by every learner through various skill development and value added credit based certificate courses made available in the college or other institutes (such credits need to be approved by the Principal in consultation with Examination Committee and Management) or not more than 2 credits to be allotted for leadership roles in NCC/ NSS/ extraordinary performance (such credits also need to be approved by the Principal in consultation with Examination Committee and Management). Dr. Vishnu Kanhere asked about certificate courses available in the college to which Dr. Kolet said 11 courses are currently available; 13 more credit based certificate courses have been added during this academic year and more such courses are on the planning board and being designed by various departments. Dr. Kolet said the policy is being tested from current year 2021-22 for general implementation and is working fine; further adding that a separate grade card for the additional 12 credits would be issued. Dr. Man Mohan said such certificate courses including those available on SWAYAM portal and MOOCs would help holistic development of students. The Governing Body unanimously approved the credit policy to be implemented under autonomy from AY 2022-23 in a progressive manner.

Governing Body Resolution No. 12: The Governing Body unanimously resolved to approve the credit policy of the college to be implemented from AY 2022-23 in progressive manner wherein 120 credits would be allotted to learners as per existing norms and at least 12 additional credits would have to be collected by students through various credit based certificate courses available in the college (or external courses or leadership role in college activities approved by the Principal, Examination Committee and Management).

Agenda 5: To approve syllabi to be taught to Second Year classes from academic year 2022-2023 (changes approved in respective Boards of Studies and Academic Council)

Subjects of CS, IT, Foundation Course, Human Science, Inter Disciplinary Studies, Mathematics, Physics, Statistics: Changes and up gradations done in second year syllabi of Computer Science, Information Technology, Foundation Course, Inter Disciplinary Studies, Mathematics, Physics and Statistics were approved by the Governing Body. Human Science syllabi were held up due to technical error and not discussed in the current meeting.

Governing Body Resolution No. 13: The Governing Body unanimously resolved to approve the Second Year B.Sc. syllabi in the subjects of Computer Science, Information Technology, Foundation Course, Inter Disciplinary Studies, Mathematics, Physics and Statistics for introduction from AY 2022-23.
