

Agenda 4 : Formation of equivalence committee for credit evaluation for autonomy and NEP: I/C Principal madam discussed the challenge of admitting students from other Affiliated colleges to autonomous and NEP pattern of syllabi at SYBSc and TYBSc levels. She proposed that if such students complete 12 extra credits with certificate courses from NEP-Basket then they should be given a degree by the end of third year. Ragade sir added that let students earn credits from any course of their choice. It was unanimously agreed by all members of council and Resolution No 43 was passed in this respect.

Agenda 5 : Any other matter with the permission of Chair: At the end Examination committee chairperson Dr. Meshram discussed the issue of cross ATKT students who lose their academic year due to more number of ATKT in different subjects. She appealed to the council to resolve this problem by allowing admission to students irrespective of the number of ATKT, the same was supported by IC



Principal madam at next year NEP syllabi (instead of Autonomous Syllabi) will be implemented in TYBSc Level. It was unanimously agreed by all members of council and Resolution No. 44 was passed in this respect.





