MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)
BETWEEN

Rizvi Education Society's Rizvi College of Arts, Science & Commerce, Rizvi Educational
Complex,
Off. Carter Road, Bandra (West), Mumbai 400050, Maharashtra.

This MOU is entered into on the day of 18th February of 2025 by and between Vidya Prasarak Mandal's B.N. Bandodkar College of Science (Autonomous) (hereinafter called BNBCS), Thane, and Rizvi Education Society's Rizvi College of Arts, Science & Commerce (hereinafter called RCACS) Maharashtra College of Arts, Commerce and Science (hereinafter called RCACS) situated at Bandra, Mumbai and both the college are affiliated to University of Mumbai.

The aforesaid Institutes are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as Institutes.

1. Objectives of MOU:

The objectives of MoU are:

- a) To promote and enhance mutual cooperation of Academic and social Interest between BNBCS and RCACS.
- b) To provide advice and inputs for enhancement of quality of education at BNBCS and RCACS.
- c) To motivate faculty and students of both institutes for participating in each other's conferences, seminars and workshops.
- d) To collaborate for starting new short-term courses and student/staff exchanges.
- e) To promote continuing education, curricular, co-curricular, extra-curricular and start up activities between Institutes.
- f) To promote educational, social awareness activities related to Biodiversity rich areas of Maharashtra.

2. Technical areas of collaboration:

- a) Provide academic interaction between institutes by promoting invited lectures and webinars at BNBCS and RCACS on relevant topics.
- b) Provide facilities for mutual exchange of students and staff for academics.
- c) Provide necessary help and collaboration wherever possible in organizing conferences/seminars/ workshops and personality development life skill training programmes between Institutes for enhancement of skills in respect of staff and students.
- d) Jointly organizing webinars, conferences and training workshops.
- e) Usage of academic infrastructure of both institutes by students and faculty members wherever and whenever possible.
- f) Arranging talks, webinars on personality development, soft skills, tourism etc for students of both Institutes.
- g) Cooperate in activities of mutual interest especially in activities related to NCC, NSS and DLLE.
- h) To facilitate training sessions for teachers and students whenever possible.
- i) Mutual co-operation between IQAC's of both Institutes.
- j) Guidance for enhancement in infrastructural development of Institutes.

3. Proposed modes of collaboration:

BNBCS and MCACS jointly propose to collaborate through the following:

- a) Co-operation and promotion of education and training in areas of mutual interests and conducting short term courses, webinars, conferences and workshops.
- b) Any other appropriate modes of interaction agreed upon between both institutes.
- c) A specific plan will be worked out by the Institutes depending upon requirement and availability of resources.

4. Terms and Conditions:

- a) For continuing education to teachers and students, the financial arrangements will be made as per the mutually agreed terms.
- b) For the visits related to advice and consultancy, travel and other expenses of both the faculty and staff shall be reimbursed on mutually agreed terms.
- c) The faculty members and students can use the library facility and exchange interests for the same.

d) Usage of academic infrastructure can be allowed for limited period subject to its availability, approval of head of facility/department and Institute norms.

e) Both Institutes agree to help, identify and invite the faculty members and researchers from the other Institute to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses and as advisory/organizing committee members and to give preference wherever possible to staff and students participating in Conferences, Workshops, Seminars activities and training programs conducted by either institutes.

f) On mutual consent of both the Institutes, review meetings will be conducted once in four months with co-coordinators.

5. Confidentiality:

a) The Institutes agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the Institutes as being confidential which is obtained from either Institute or created during the performance of the MoU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other Institute.

b) The above confidential clause under this MoU excludes the information/data possessed by either Institute before entering into the MoU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

6. Duration of MOU:

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written consent of the Institutes, shall expire in **Three Years** after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. On review, the MOU shall be extended by mutual consent. This MoU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the Institutes at any time. Either institute shall have the right to terminate this MoU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other institute.

7. Coordinators:

Both Institutes will designate persons who will have responsibility for co-ordination and implementation of this agreement.

8. Intellectual Property Rights:





- 2) To motivate & promote activities to its utmost to ensure sufficient number of Registration at iFuture Technologies., for conducting Orientation & Practical Sessions on IT Internship for COLLEGE students.
- 3) The college needs to share the students' information in the format shared by iFuture Technologies, to have a smooth onboarding process for conducting Orientation & Practical Sessions on IT Internship
- 4) As per iFuture Technologies policies, we need student Father's signature for IT Internship Registration Form as & an when scheduled either in Corporate Office Kalyan or Regional Office Thane

5. Mutual Obligations:

Either party is not authorized to make any representation, contract, or commitment on behalf of the other party without the prior written consent of other party.

6. General:

- 1) Both parties shall not use the name and brand of the other party in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other.
- 2) Each party shall be at liberty to terminate this MoU with a written notice period of one (1) month to the other party without any compensation and seeking legal redress. In the event of termination, each Party shall be required to pay forthwith any outstanding payments due to the other party and also complete all ongoing training programs.

7. Modification

No amendment, modification or waiver of any provisions of this MoU shall be effective unless the same is in writing and signed or executed by both the Parties.

Objective: To appoint students learning computers as major subject as volunteers and spread cyber security awareness among students & society at large.

- **Coordination and Planning:** Coordinate with club officers and plan police sessions at the institutional level, prepare and submit execution plans, and ensure timely report submissions.
- **Mentorship and Guidance:** Mentor the club throughout all stages, conduct brainstorming sessions for innovative ideas, and review team performance to provide suggestions and guidance for improvement.
- **Media and Coverage:** Encourage and support extensive media coverage through both online and offline channels to maximize the initiative's visibility.

2. **Club President:**

- **Leadership and Coordination:** Lead the club, ensure smooth functioning, and coordinate activities. Assist the teacher coordinator in selecting and training cyber warriors and support the formation of committees under club officers.
- **Planning and Monitoring:** Ensure adherence to the execution plan by monitoring activities and timelines. Conduct weekly review meetings to oversee progress and facilitate brainstorming sessions for innovative mass and impact activities.
- **Support for Record-Keeping:** Support the teacher coordinator in maintaining records and reporting, in collaboration with the secretary, to ensure accurate documentation and reporting of club activities.

3. **Club Secretary:**

- **Planning and Reporting:** Compile execution plans from all cyber warriors and collaborate with the Activity Director to finalize the plan. Maintain and update the status deck daily, gathering performance details in coordination with the Activity and Media Directors. Prepare and submit weekly reports, including minutes of meetings and photo evidence, to the teacher coordinator

Compile execution plans from all warriors to create a comprehensive club-level plan and submit it to the secretary and teacher coordinator. Maintain and update records in the database, ensuring they are shared with the secretary and teacher coordinator, and coordinate live visits as per the plan.

5. Media Director

- **Publicity and Outreach:** Manage publicity, social media, and outreach to effectively promote the project. Update the status deck based on QHF's scoreboard, ensure all online outreach targets are met, and encourage maximum promotion of every activity through social, online, and offline media. Maintain and update records of all promotional activities.

6. Cyber Warrior:

- **Execution & outreach:** Plan and conduct presentations in schools and colleges to sensitize students, coordinate impact activities both mob-based and community-based and enhance online outreach through various digital activities. Share the list of identified schools with the Activity Director and work towards meeting outreach targets.

Payment disbursements (INR) by QHF to the Institute:

1. Rs. 900/- Stipend per presentation for student volunteer working under Earn & Learn scheme and reaching minimum 1000 students through 5 presentations. Any deviation without written communication will not be considered.
2. Rs.200/- per presentation for faculty / college to take ownership of monitoring conduction of successful presentations by students and reporting in prescribed format to QHF.
3. Rs.1100/- to each club officer for monitoring smooth conduction of activities and assisting teacher coordinator. If 2 weekly reports are missed, 50% payment will be deducted and if 3 or more weekly reports are missed 100% payment will be deducted.

Disbursement of payment will be done only after verification of required documents in stipulated time. Upon successful completion of the presentations by the student volunteers herein, QHF shall transfer payments to the bank account of students and teachers. Teacher must ensure to submit bank details of all volunteers and teachers in prescribed format along with cancelled cheques scanned copy added to Folder following the same sequence of volunteer's names in volunteer details (Template E&L file). The bank / post saving account details must be shared with QHF before first presentation is delivered
