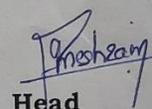

All are requested to carry one book other than academic. Attendance is compulsory.

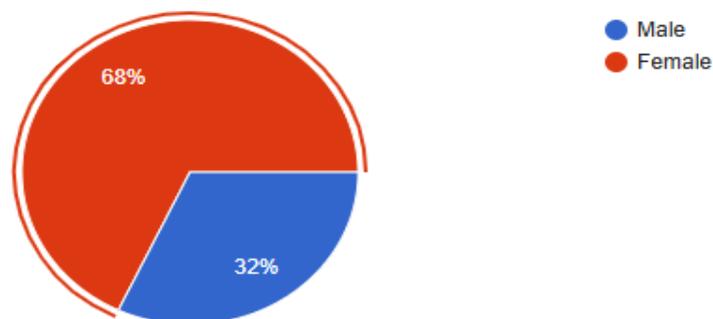

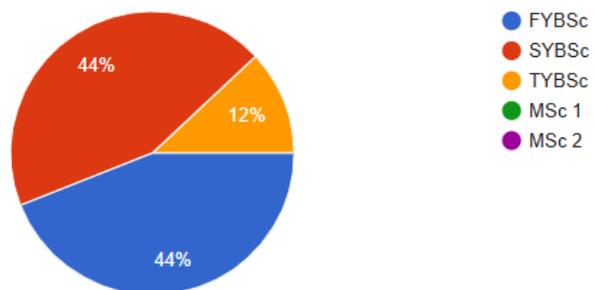
