(max. three)	<p>and eighteen. Children receive instruction at the grade level. Higher education is provided to children who are interested. There are programs that teach life skills, such as culinary and career skills. self-care instruction, safety instruction, etc.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Well-being & Health: Children are often examined by doctors. Children can receive mental health support services to help them cope with life's transitions. • Social and Emotional Growth: Adults in the orphanage are married to families following the groom's proper background investigation. Lost children are reunited with their families. In order to improve the lives of girls who lack social support, Parivartan Mahila Sanstha has launched four projects. Vada Mokhada, Bal Haq, Swarkiniwas to train females for safety (550 registered candidates), Dilasa Daycare Center (self-care training), and VCPC (teaching villagers about the necessary reforms).
